Scholarship Awarded to: Accredited Institution

Amount: Up to \$1000

Basis of Selection:

The scholarship shall be given to any resident of Crooked River Ranch who is a high school graduate or equivalent to fund his/her education. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of merit and motivation and shall be for the immediately upcoming academic year. There will be no deferrals. The selection will be made by the Crooked River Ranch Lions Scholarship Advisory Committee. To be considered for this scholarship, finalists will be scheduled for an in-person or phone interview with the Committee on Saturday, April 15, 2017 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

The recipient will be announced no later than April 28, 2017.

Only completed applications, including all signatures requested, attachments such as transcripts and two letters of recommendation received in a single packet by Crooked River Ranch Lions Club at their post office box (see below) by April 3rd of the scholarship year will be considered. If the deadline falls on a weekend, the following Monday will be used as the deadline date. The Crooked River Ranch Lions members will not acknowledge receipt of applications. If verification of receipt is desired, send the application via Certified US Mail or any carrier that has tracking ability. **Faxes are not accepted.**

Late applications will not be considered.

Submit two letters of recommendation from references who are **not** related to you.
